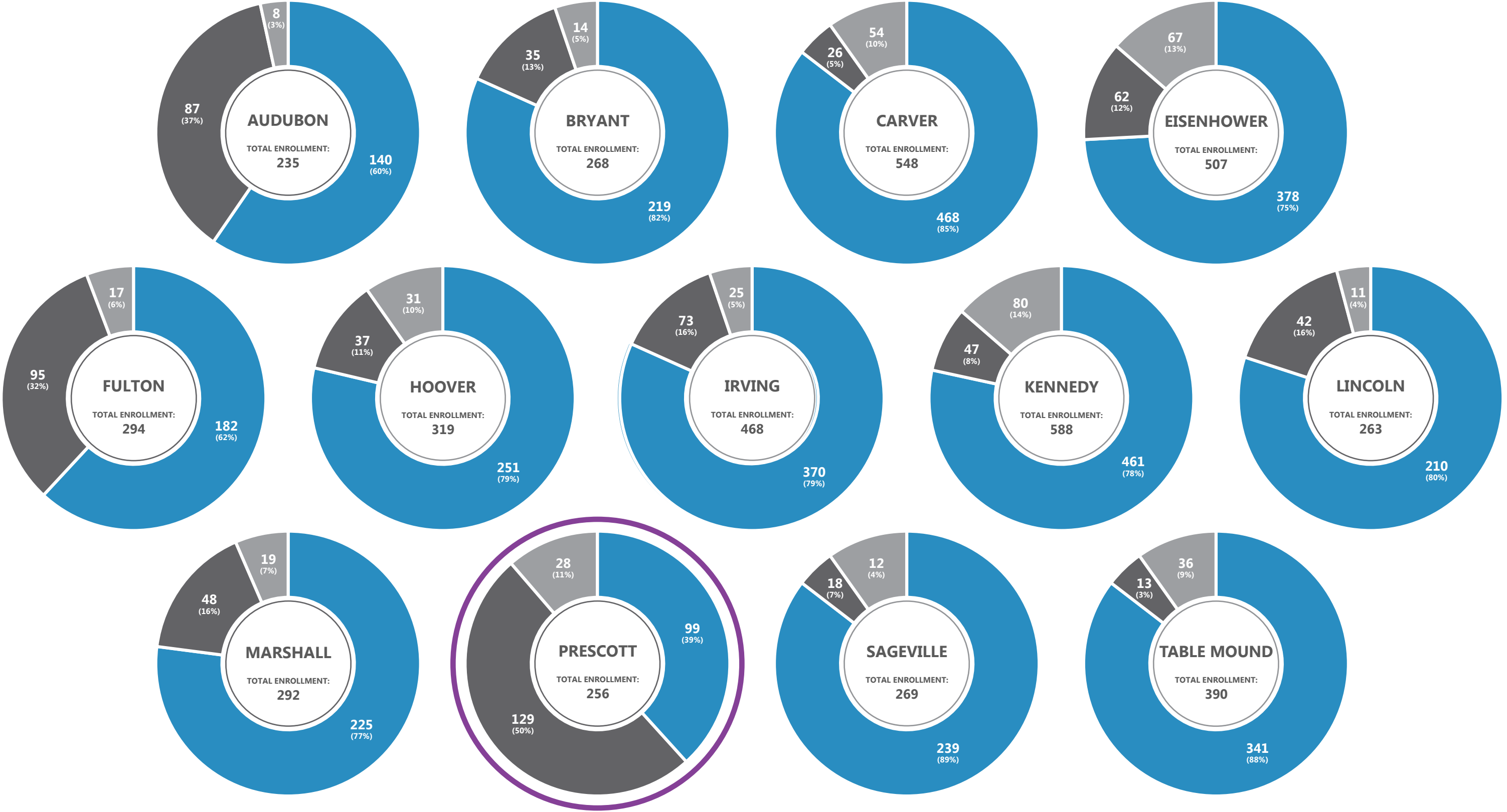


K-5 Enrollment by Home Boundary

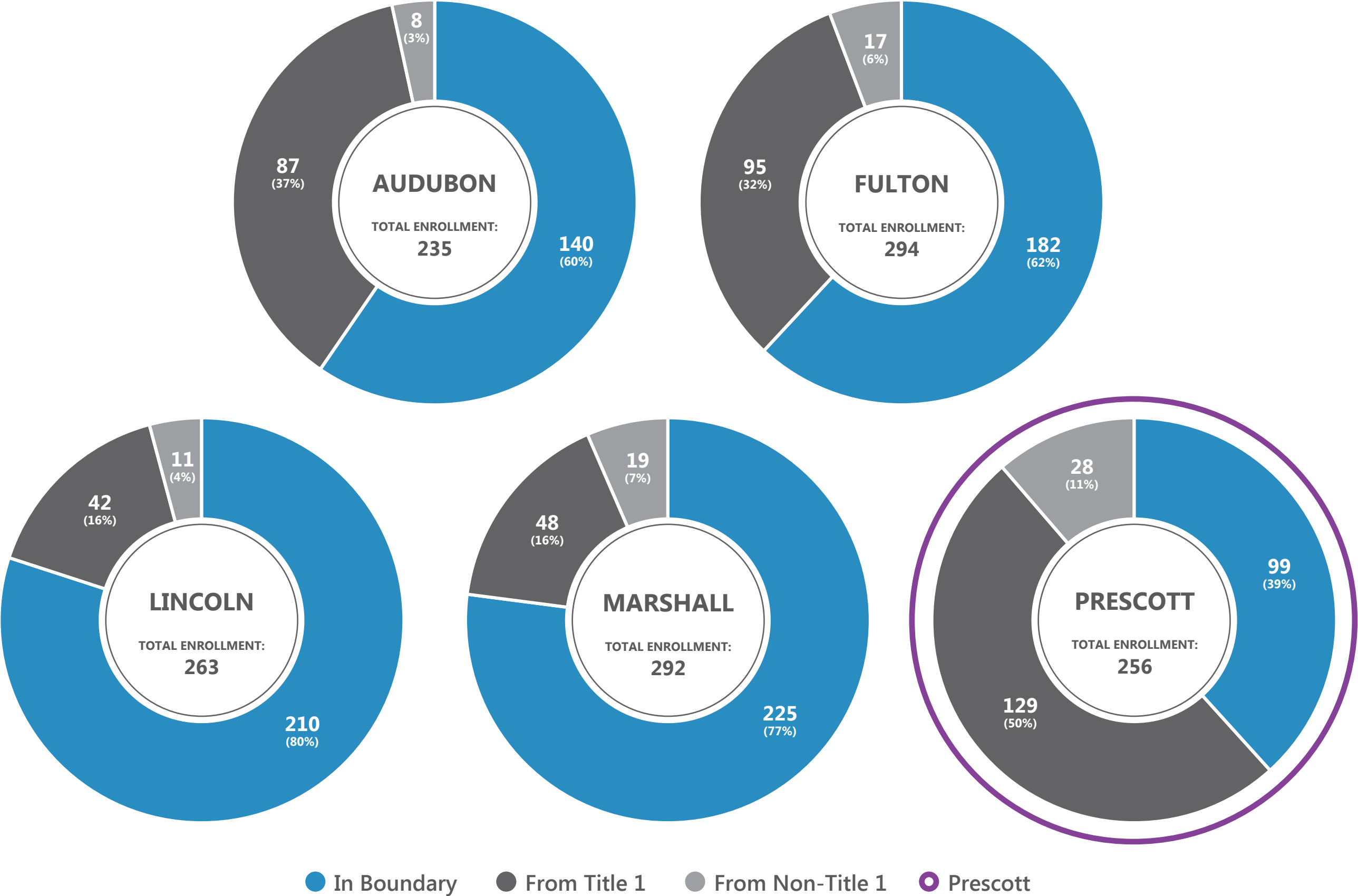

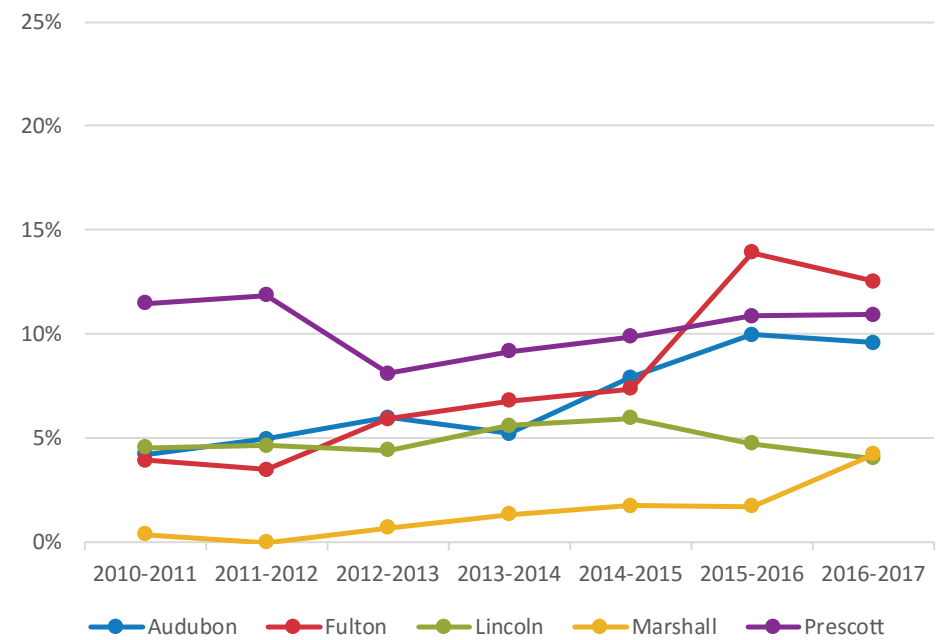

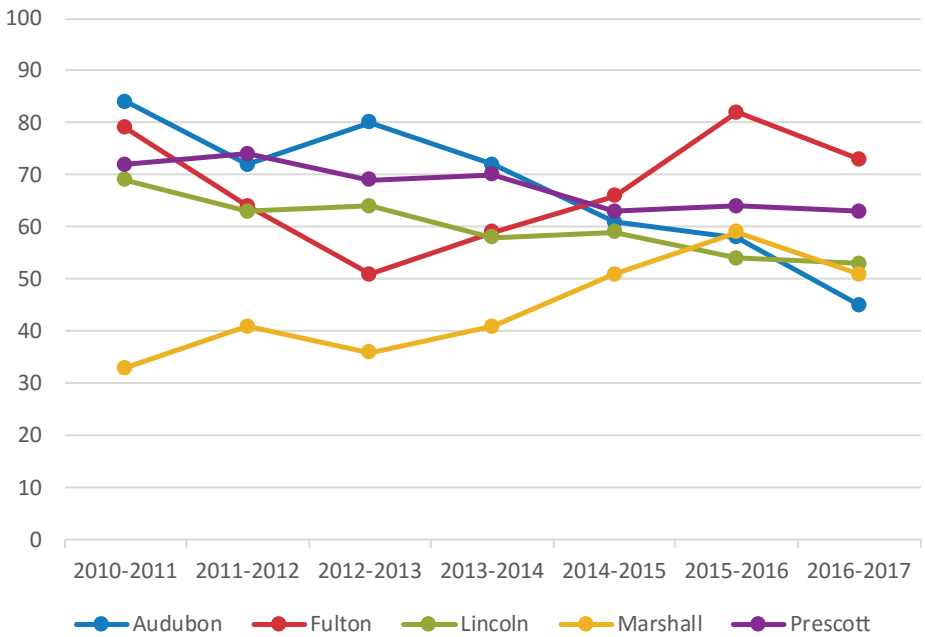

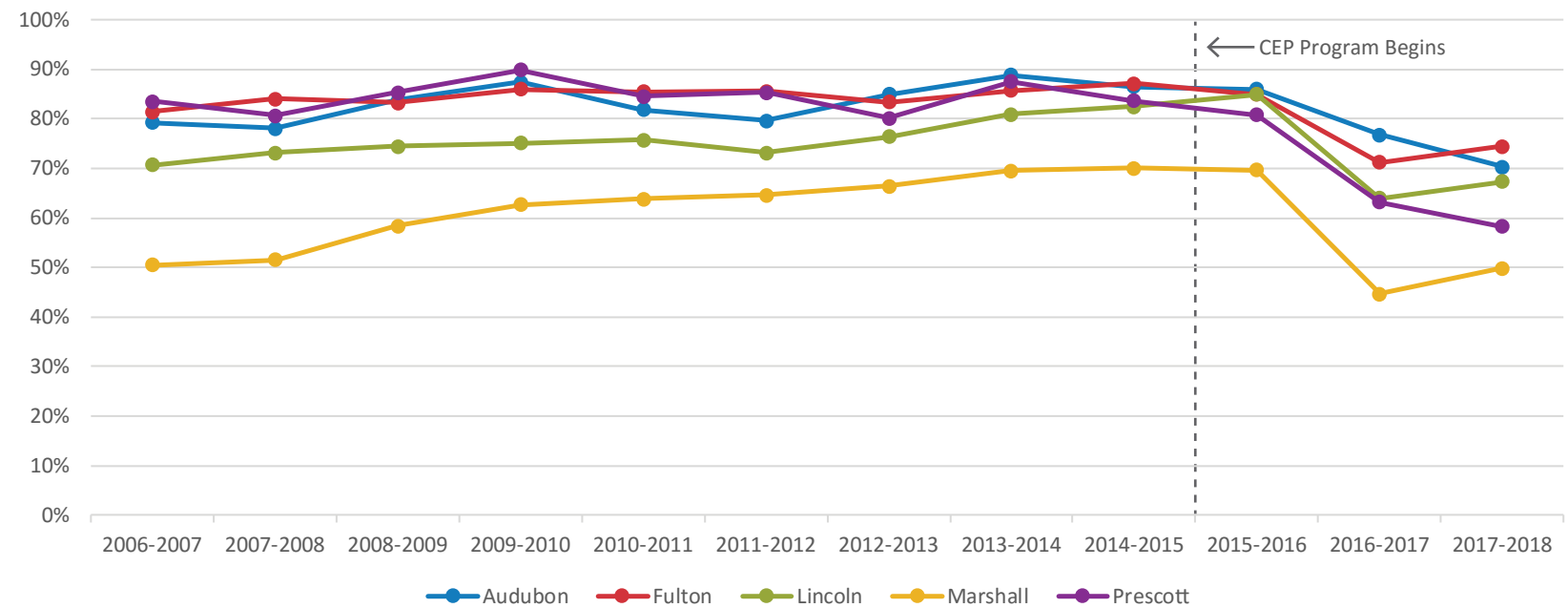
Percentage of English Language Learners (ELL)



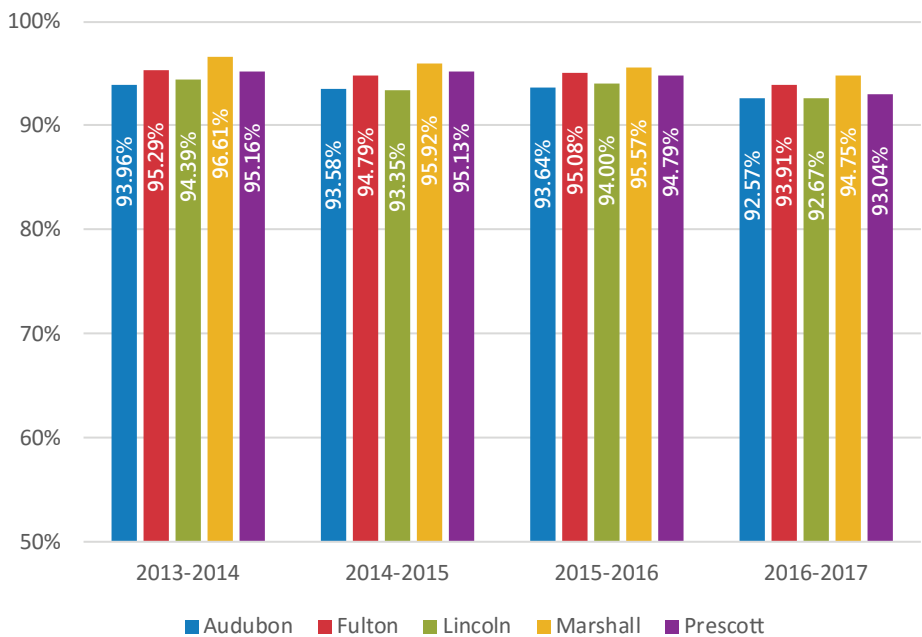
Number of Students Receiving Special Education Instructional Support



Percentage of Students Eligible for Free or Reduced Meals



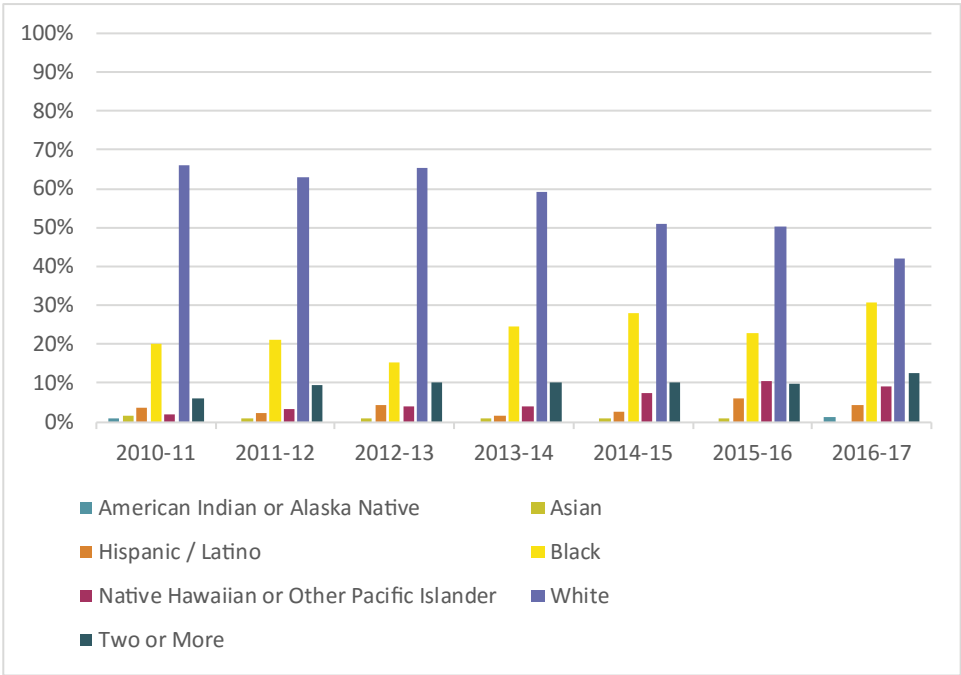
Average Daily Attendance by School



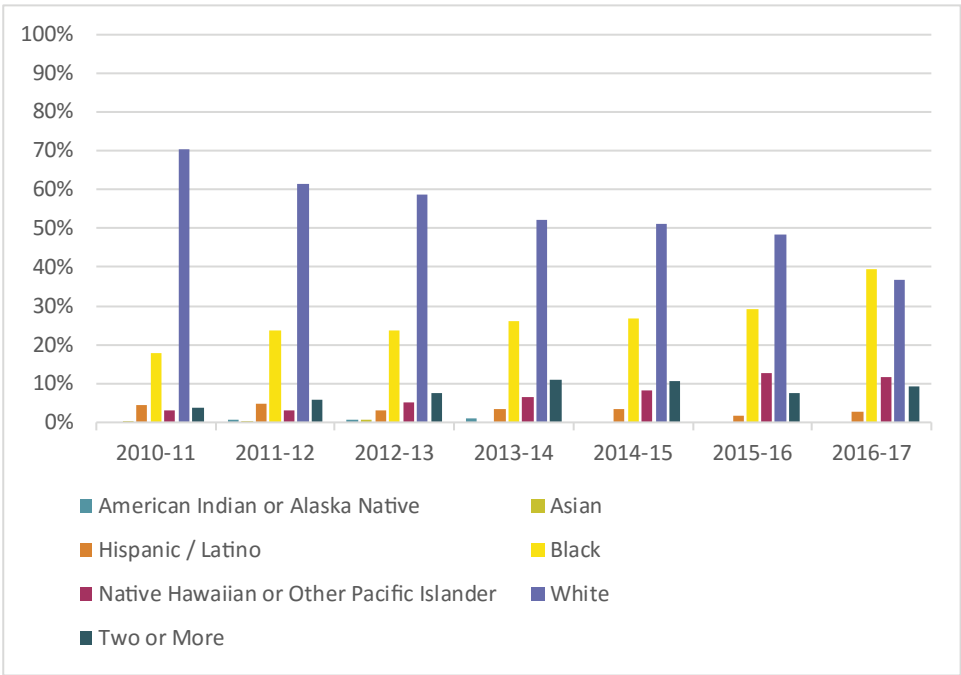

Comparison Over Time (Matched Cohort / Fall Testing)

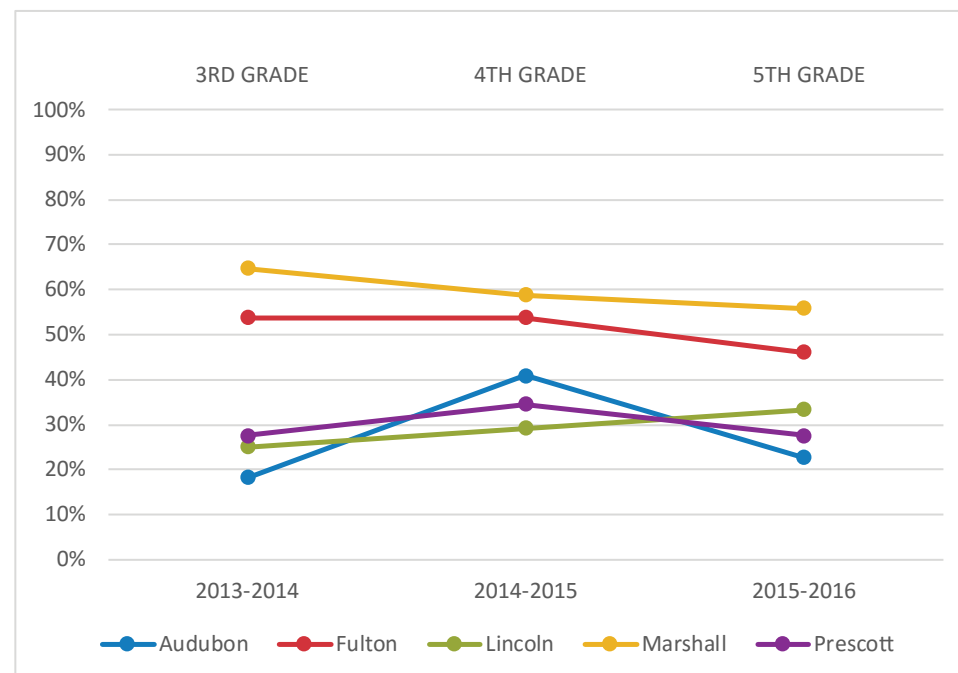

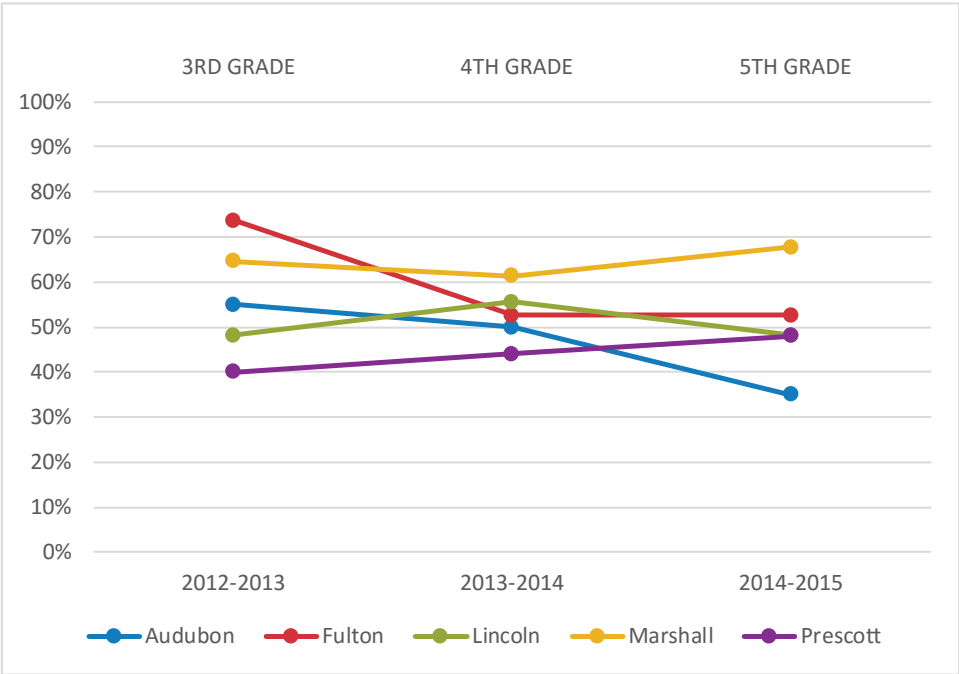

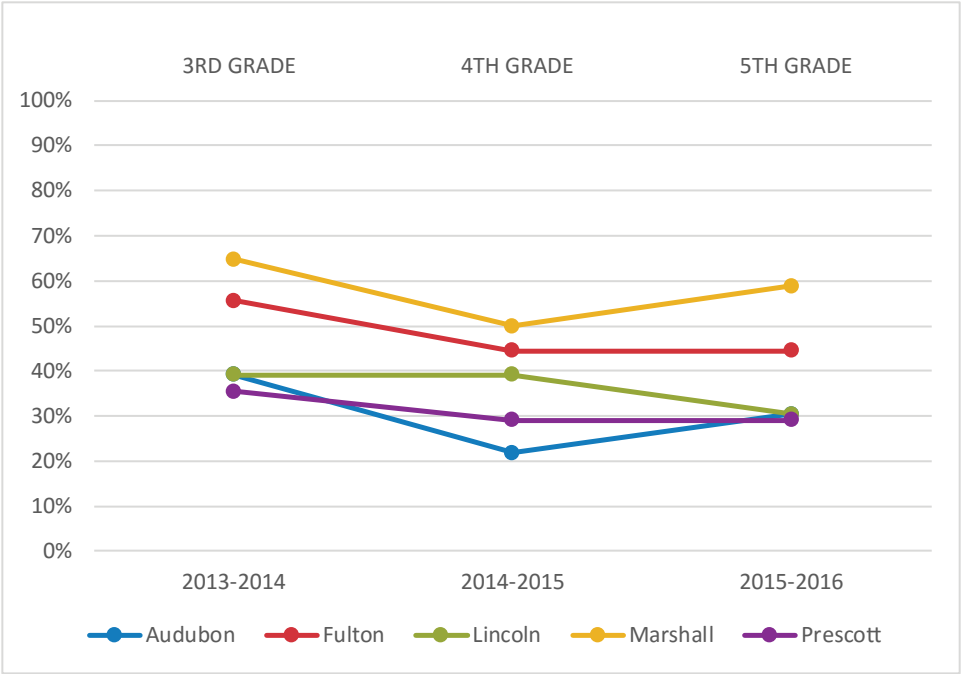

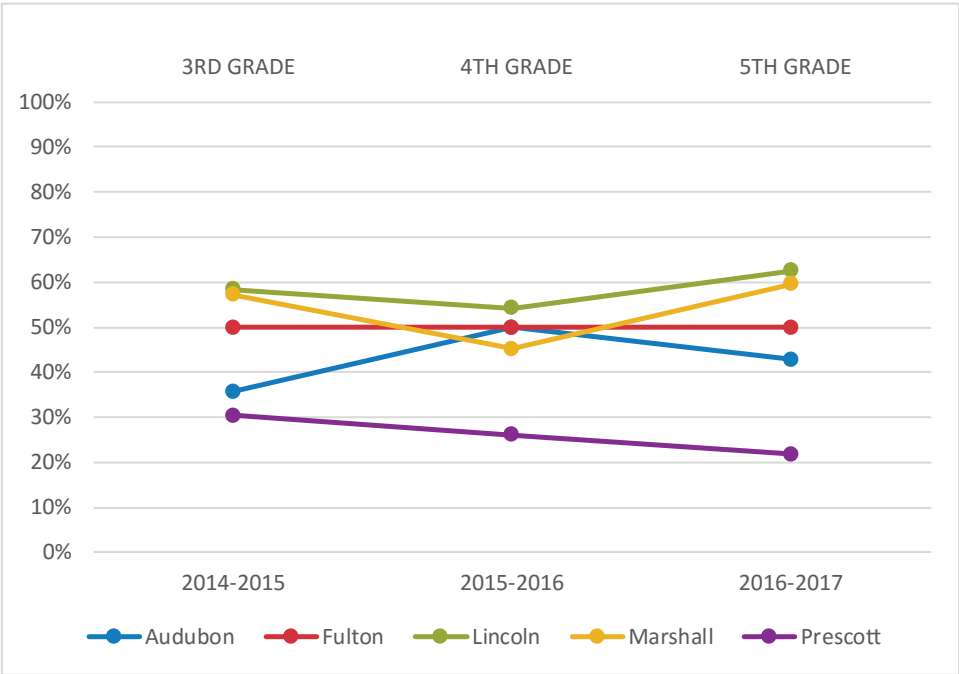

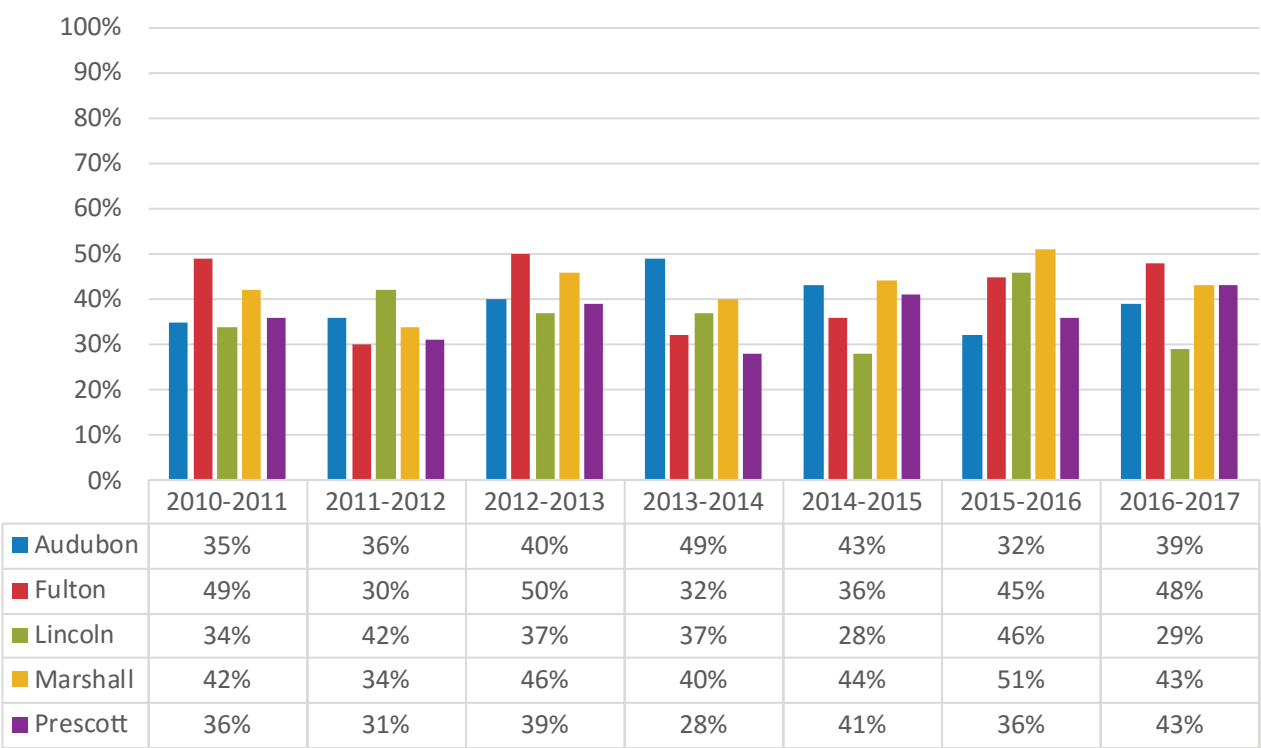
Percent Meeting Fall-to-Spring Growth Projection
