NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL/SCHOOL GENERAL ELECTION FOR ALL INCORPORATED CITIES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITHIN DUBUQUE COUNTY, IOWA ON NOVEMBER 5, 2019.

Public notice is hereby given to qualified electors in the incorporated cities of Asbury, Balltown, Bankston, Bernard, Cascade, Centralia, Dubuque, Durango, Dyersville, Epworth, Farley, Graf, Holy Cross, Luxemburg, New Vienna, Peosta, Rickardsville, Sageville, Sherrill, Worthington, and Zwingle all within Dubuque County, State of Iowa, that a General Election will be held in and for said cities on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the purpose of electing five (5) council members, and one (1) Mayor, unless otherwise provided by ordinance of the respective cities, in such case the numbers and offices in questions are to be in accordance with the respective ordinances adopted.

Public notice is also hereby given to the qualified electors of the Dubuque Community school district, Western Dubuque County Community school district, Maquoketa Community school district, and Monticello Community School District all within Dubuque County, State of Iowa, that the regular school election will be held in and for said Community School districts on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the purpose of electing directors for four year terms, to be voted upon at large or by director districts based on the school district, and will be voted on by electors residing in the entire school district.

The polls for the Municipal/School election shall be open from 7:00 (seven) a.m. to 8:00 (eight) p.m. on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, to receive the votes of qualified electors and for said election **Dubuque County will be using their General Election Polling sites**, and the respective polling places therefore will be as follows:

DUBUQUE WARD TWO

Voters in the city of Dubuque precincts 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 will be voting on the Ward Two council seat between **Laura Roussell** and **Luis Del Toro** for a four year term.

DUBUQUE WARD FOUR

Voters in the City of Dubuque precincts 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 will also be voting on the Ward Four Council seat between **Brad Cavanagh** and **Jay Schiesl** for a four year term.

DUBUQUE WARD THREE—TO FILL A VACANCY

Voters in the City of Dubuque precincts 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 will also be voting on the Ward Three Council seat To Fill A Vacancy between **Danny Sprank** and **Phil Atkinson** for a two year term.

DYERSVILLE WARD TWO

Voters in the city of Dyersville precinct 38 (Ward 2) will also be voting on the Ward Two council seat. **Michael J. English** filed for this position for a four year term.

NICC DIRECTOR DISTRICTS

Also to be voted upon in Dubuque Community School District precincts 5, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 31, 36 will be a four year term on the Northeast Iowa Community College Board of Directors for District Seven. In precinct 1, 2, 3, 4, 20, 43 eligible voters will vote on a four year term on the Northeast Iowa Community College Board of Directors for District Eight. Eligible voters in precinct 42 will vote on a four year term on the Northeast Iowa Community College Board of Directors for District Five.

NEW VIENNA PUBLIC MEASURE

Voters in the City of New Vienna will also be voting on Public Measure A:

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE APPROVED?

Whereas the City of New Vienna, Iowa presently has local option sales tax providing for the proceeds to be allocated fifty (50) percent for streets and, fifty (50) percent for sewer. The City Council wishes to change the allocation to provide for one hundred (100) percent for any lawful purpose of the city.

If approved the change is to go into effect on January 1, 2020.

DUBUQUE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PUBLIC MEASURE

If a majority of eligible electors voting on the question fail to approve this Revenue Purpose Statement, then upon expiration of the current Revenue Purpose Statement, revenues received by the School District from the Secure an Advanced Vision for Education fund shall be expended in the following order:

The payment of bonds for which SAVE Revenue has been pledged;

Reduction of bond levies under Iowa Code Sections 298.18 and 298.18A and all other debt levies;

Reduction of the regular and voter-approved physical plant and equipment levy under Iowa Code Section 298.2;

Reduction of the public education and recreational levy under Iowa Code Section 300.2;

For any authorized infrastructure purpose of the school district as defined in Iowa Code Section 423F.3(6); and

For the payment of principal and interest on bonds issued under Iowa Code Sections 423E.5 and 423F.4.

Voter ID Requirements

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by noon on Tuesday, November 12, 2019. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. For said election all of applicable provisions of the laws regarding registration of voters shall be complied with. All qualified electors of said Dubuque County, Iowa are hereby notified to appear at said election each to vote at the polling place at the precinct in which such electors reside. By order of the Commissioner of Elections, Dubuque County, Iowa.

Voters who have not registered by the 25th of October deadline may register and vote at the polls on November 5th. Voter's registering to vote at the polls on Election Day may do so by showing proof of identity and residence that is not more than 45-days old. A valid Iowa driver's license with current address is the best form of ID. A photo ID is necessary for proof of identification. The following items are valid as proof of residence:

- * residential lease
- * property tax statement
- * utility bill
- * bank statement
- * paycheck
- * government check
- * other government document

The document must show the voters address and be in the voter's name.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. For further information, please contact the Dubuque County Auditor's office at the telephone or E-mail address listed below.
