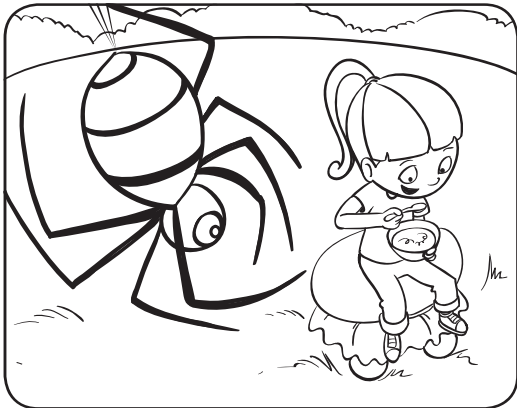
Little Miss Muffet
