

HOME/SCHOOL CONNECTION

Clouds move with the wind. They change all the time. Sometimes they block the sun. Sometimes they make shadows. They are always changing shape. Make a cloud window to look at clouds or if you can't make a cloud window, go outside and look at the clouds.

What do you notice about the clouds?

Are the clouds moving?

Did you see any cloud shapes? If so, what did you see?

Materials: Construction paper, scissors, tape

Procedure

1. Cut a 9" × 12" sheet of dark construction paper (a shopping bag will do) into four equal strips (2 1/4" × 12").
2. Form a rectangle with the four strips, overlapping one edge 1/4" over another. Tape it together.
3. Tape the cloud window to a glass window in your house. It will provide a reference point to help your child detect movement of the clouds in the sky.
