
Some people take care of people or pets.

Childcare workers take care of children when their parents are working.

Doctors help people stay healthy. If we are sick, a doctor tells us ways to get better.

Our pets have their own doctors. They are called veterinarians. They take care of sick or hurt animals.

Many people work hard to care for our community.

Police officers keep our community safe. They help people obey the community's laws. A **law** is a rule. Police officers stop people who do not obey laws.

Firefighters put out fires. They rescue people from danger. Some firefighters have extra training. They help people who are hurt or sick.

Mail carriers deliver letters and packages. They bring mail to homes and businesses.

Rangers keep parks and forests safe and clean. They also teach people about the plants and animals that live there.
