Comparatives and Superlatives

Comparatives and **superlatives** are special forms of adjectives. They are used in comparing two or more things.

- To form the comparative and superlative forms of a one-syllable adjective, add -er for the comparative form and -est for the superlative.
- To form comparatives and superlatives for most words that have two or more syllables and don't end in *y*, use the words *more* and *most* or *less* and *least* before the adjective.
