

**Parts of Speech:
Pronouns**

Pronouns are words that take the place of one or more nouns.
(she, they, he, them, we, us, I, you, it, him, her, me, your)

Example 1: *Zoey* likes to read about pirates.

She likes to read about pirates.

Zoey is the noun in the sentence. The pronoun *she* replaces the noun.

Example 2: *My sister, my brother, my dad, and I* went hiking yesterday.

We went hiking yesterday.

My sister, my brother, my dad, and I are the plural nouns in the sentence. The pronoun *we* replaces the nouns.
