Context Clues

When you use **context clues**, you figure out the meaning of an unfamiliar word by using the words around it. There are four types of context clues.



Explanation or Definition	The author explains or defines a word. The definition may be separated with a comma and words such as <i>or</i>
	or which means. Here, the definition of bicameral
	follows the comma.
	The U.S. Congress is bicameral, which means it
	has two chambers or houses.

Example Clues	The author gives examples of a word, usually after signal words, such as <i>for example</i> or <i>such as</i> , as shown here:
	Council members have many obligations, such
	as going to meetings and reading about new
	laws.

Synonym Clues	The author gives a word or phrase that is a synonym for a word. In the sentences below, the synonym for <i>reluctant</i> is <i>hesitant</i> .
	Leaders may be reluctant to vote for unpopular laws. They are <mark>hesitant</mark> because they might lose the next election.

Antonym Clues	The author gives an antonym for a word. Words such as <i>unlike</i> or <i>on the other hand</i> may signal an antonym is coming. Here, the antonym for <i>ecstatic</i> is <i>unhappy</i> .
	Voters in this state were ecstatic about the result, unlike the unhappy voters in the state next to ours.
