## THIRD GRADE NEWS MRS. OLBERDING, MRS. VAN CLEVE, MRS. TAUBER

Third grade students have been hard-working, busy learners in the classroom. Along with our daily learning, we still continue to practice and emphasize our school and classroom rules to show excellence.

In Social Studies with Mrs. Olberding, students have been talking about Ruby Bridges and how she made history for our schools today.

Mrs. Van Cleve and Mrs. Tauber have been focusing on structures of life in Science, investigating seeds and after Winter break they will have crayfish in the classroom to observe.

Our new Math program is working to help students model and use a variety of strategies to solve addition, subtraction, and multiplication problems.

During the afternoon Language Arts block students are working on various comprehension strategies and skills along with fluency both in whole group and small group, using different stories to increase student engagement.

In Writing, students are getting the opportunity to brainstorm ideas to write about and to do more free writing along with using a focus zone.

Along with our Health curriculum, we have monthly visits from Geri Buelow, a Certified Prevention Specialist from the Substance Abuse Services Center. She teaches a Life Skills program to our students with each lesson focusing on promoting healthy lifestyles and good decision making. Students also enjoy our monthly Yoga Day to take time to practice mindfulness.

# MARSHALL 2020-2021 PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION OPENS MONDAY, JANUARY 13 - 7:00 AM

The Dubuque Community School District will be hosting Preschool Registration for the 2020-2021 school year at each elementary school that provides preschool services. Spaces are limited and the registration is on a first come, first served basis.

Parents/Guardians are allowed to pick up registration forms in advance from schools, or the district office, but forms cannot be turned in until January 13 starting at 7:00 am at the school site's Main Office.

You will need to determine if you want your student to attend the AM or PM session for preschool, as classes are offered in half day segments only. Students do not have to attend their home school preschool. You may register at any of the DCSD's preschools. Please have all paperwork and documents ready before you arrive to register.
