

Discounted City Utilities Program

The City offers income-qualified residential customers a reduction in monthly fees for all four City utilities (water, sanitary sewer, refuse collection, and storm water) of up to 50% of the base rate. Customers must submit an application for consideration and applications are reviewed on an annual basis.

Struggling to afford internet?

You may be eligible for **DISCOUNTED OR FREE INTERNET** through the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP).

How It Works

ACP gives a discount on your household's monthly internet service. Participating internet service providers will apply this discount directly to your service plan.

If eligible, your household can receive:

- \$30 per month discount on wireless internet plans and a free phone
- OR \$30 per month discount on wired internet service to your home
- One-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer. A small fee will be required.

Your household may be eligible if someone in the household:

- Receives SNAP, Medicaid, or other government benefits, or
- Meets income guidelines, or
- Goes to a school where they receive free or reduced-price lunch and breakfast.
