Last week the Building Leadership Team analyzed our fall data. Today I would like to share our MAP (Measures of Academic Progress in Grades 2 –Grade 5 in reading and math. In upcoming weeks I will share more data.

When analyzing data, we look at growth over time and these factors: gender, special education, Gifted and Talented, minorities and free and reduced lunch. One of the biggest discrepancies we noticed was achievement between girls and boys and that our math scores are much higher than reading. Although each grade level scored higher than the norm RIT mean in MAP, some students are not making their RIT target growth year after year. During conferences you'll have an opportunity to discuss these scores with your child's teacher. This is just one data point for your child. We also need to factor in your child's FAST score and what their performance looks like in the classroom. Hopefully this will be a rich discussion next week at conferences.


