#### **Understanding Overall Performance**

The overall performance includes both an overall score and performance rating for all lowa schools across a number of performance measures. In addition, the Every Student Succeeds Act performance category identifies schools who are struggling or who have student groups who are underperforming. The overall score provides a single number which is the sum of the measures below. It provides a snapshot of school performance, but may not tell the entire story about performance of students in that

This week, the district will launch an updated version of Raptor, the district's visitor management system. As you likely know, this system allows us to manage visitors in our buildings and runs a check across the National Sex Offender Registry each time an individual visits a school.

ONE IMPORTANT CHANGE FOR THIS VERSION is that we are asking all individuals to bring a valid photo ID the next time you visit one of our buildings, even if you have visited previously.

Once you login to a building with your ID, the system will allow for visitor information to be looked up across all buildings in the district and will help create a more efficient, streamlined sign-in process.

As always, each time an individual visits a building, they will be cross checked against the registry and will be printed a timestamped ID for the duration of their visit.

Raptor continues to be one of the many layers of safety we employ in the district, and we are thankful for your continued support of these safety efforts.
