- · All 13 Dubuque Community School District elementary schools offer preschool.
- · What are the requirements?
- 1. Family has to reside in the state of Iowa
- 2. Child has to be four years old by September 15, 2022
- 3. There are no financial guidelines to meet, SWVPP is free for all fours.
- · When? Monday, January 10, 2022 at 7:00 a.m. at all elementary schools Slots do fill fast! Mark your calendars! Come early!
- · What do I need to bring? Bring proof-of-age (birth certificate, passport, baptismal certificate) Registration will not be taken without proof-of-age. Children DO NOT need to be present for registration. This is the paperwork process.
