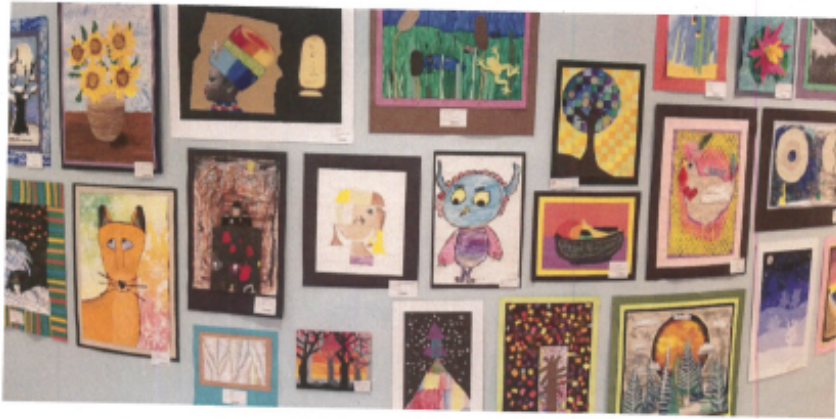
ILLNESS POLICY
