Thursday, May 26th: Carver PTG Fun Night (5:00 PM-7:00 PM at Carver)

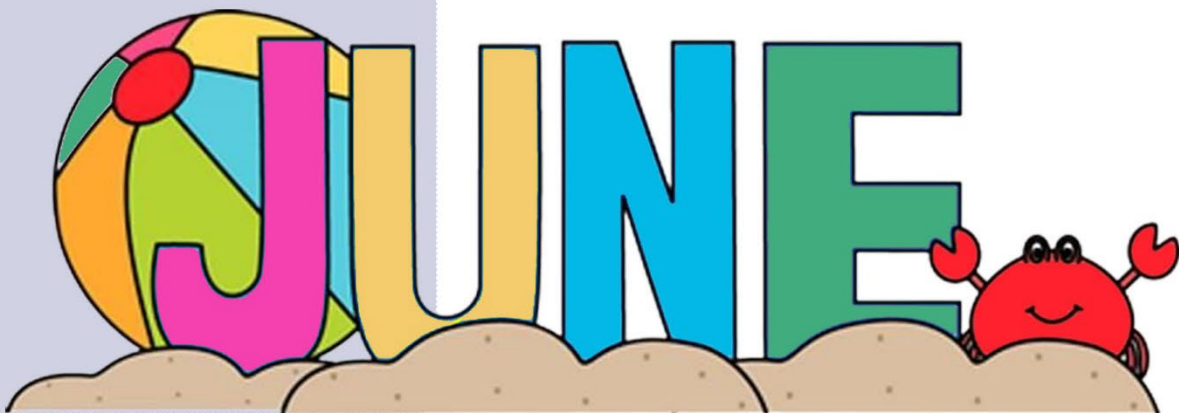
Wednesday, June 1st: Carver Fun Day (during the school day at Carver)
