Junior Achievement (JA) is a non-profit organization that provides economics based programs in schools. Using colorful and engaging materials, JA volunteers teach students the basics about business, financial literacy, and free enterprise, to inspire and prepare young people to succeed in a global economy. Junior Achievement works with grades K-12 at the educator's request.

JA volunteers are provided with training and a kit of materials. Each kit contains easy-to-follow speaking points and materials for hands-on learning activities. The programs require five - seven classroom visits with lessons running 30 - 45 minutes per visit. The classroom visits are scheduled by the volunteer and educator in a way that works best for both.
