Dear Eisenhower Families,

I hope this newsletter finds you doing well. In an attempt to honor your time and be brief, I will give you some highlights of major happenings going on at Eisenhower.

- At this time last year we were in the midst of a brutal winter and dealing with many weather related school cancellations and delays. It's nice that the winter this year has been more forgiving so far. Please continue to ensure that your child is dressed for the weather as we do go outside daily for recess except with the wind chill is below zero.
- January was a busy month for us. We focused on our character word of the month which was perseverance. We celebrated all of the "Difference Makers" who help our school be a great place to learn and grow. Students also took part in lessons on computer programming during our Hour of Code week. And our students completed our winter district assessments for FAST (Kindergarten and 1st grade for math, K-5 for reading) and our MAP test (2nd-5th graders). You will receive information about these results at our conferences coming up next week.
- Teachers have also been busy with numerous professional development sessions. We have been focusing on our most current assessments to help inform us of the best ways to improve student learning and increase achievement. We have also learned more about mindfulness and how to help students manage emotions and self-regulate their feelings. Teachers have been extremely busy as we continue the implementation of our new math curriculum, Math Bridges. The implementation year of any new curriculum is challenging from a planning and instructional delivery standpoint, but teachers have done an awesome job of delivering outstanding instruction in the area of math and early word is that students are responding well to this new curriculum.
- As I mentioned before, our spring conferences will be taking place next week on February 18, 19, and 20. We will have evening conferences on the 18th and 19th and then morning conferences on the 20th. Students will not have school on February 20th or 21st. We look forward to seeing you at your scheduled conferences and continuing our educational partnership on behalf of your children.
- Looking ahead, our character word for this month is Kindness. We have also revised and condensed our Eisenhower school rules so be sure to ask your child about those and how we are showing kindness at Eisenhower. In March we will focus on respect and we are busy planning a "Respect Week" on March 2-6 where we will partner with Special Olympics on the concept of respect and inclusion. Our leadership students will also be coordinating a service project to benefit Special Olympics.
- The end of our 2nd trimester occurs on February 27 so teachers will be completing the standards based progress reports for your child at the end of the month. These will be ready for your viewing on March 6 with updated information and comments.
- In March, look for ways to communicate any needs or requests for next school year.


Secondary Open Enrollment. Applications currently being accepted through 4:00 p.m. on Monday, 3/2/2020.
