Hello Eisenhower Families!

Happy (almost) Spring! Here are some announcements and major events that have occurred or will be occurring soon.

- We just completed an awesome Respect Week! The theme was "Choose to Include" and we focused on showing respect and making sure everyone felt included. We were designated a Unified Champion School by Iowa Special Olympics and we are proud of that honor. Our students have done a great job of respecting differences and being inclusive! At Eisenhower we are Difference Makers!
- Kindergarten Night is coming up on Tuesday, March 31 from 5:30-7:00 p.m. This is for incoming kindergarten students for the 2020-21 school year. Please spread the word to anyone you know who has an incoming kindergarten student and encourage them to contact the main office at Eisenhower if they have any questions.
- A quick word about pick-up, drop-off, and being neighborly... Please continue to be courteous and SAFE when dropping off or picking up your child from school. During the morning drop off, please pull all the way ahead in the drop off line and have students exit vehicles in a timely manner so we can keep the line moving. I also have a request from neighbors of Eisenhower. When you park in the neighborhood or are sitting in your vehicle waiting for your child, please park in designated areas only. Do not park in driveways and do not block driveways or mailboxes. We strive to be neighborly to the surrounding houses but we need everyone to abide by those simple rules. Thank you!
- We have our annual ISASP tests coming up for grades 3-5. These ISASP tests are the state assessments and have recently replaced the ITP test, and for those of us who are older, the ITBS assessments. This is the first year this test will be taken on the computer so results will be more timely and usable. Your child's teacher will keep you informed of specific test dates for your grade level. Please encourage your child to do their best on this assessment and ensure they have a good night of sleep and a healthy breakfast.
- This is the time of year when we begin to make preliminary plans for next school year and we will soon start to make plans for staffing and homeroom assignments. My protocol for specific teacher requests is that I will receive them but I make no promises other than considering each one carefully and attempting to honor each reasonable request. I feel strongly that we have a school of excellent teachers and your child(ren) will have a successful experience no matter which homeroom they are assigned.
