A Note from Mrs. Haas: Even though we are 2/3 of the way through the school year, it is not too late to change your child's attendance habits. Good attendance is essential to your child's success! Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school, and themselves. Start building this habit in elementary school so children learn right away that going to school on time, every day, is important. Good attendance habits built while children are still young will help them to do well in high school, college and at work. The following is a list of things that you can do to help ensure that your child attends school on time every day: Set a regular bedtime and morning routine. Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before. Don't let your child stay home unless he/she is truly sick. Keep in mind complaints of a stomachache or headache can be a sign of anxiety and are not always a reason to stay home. If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, school counselors, or other parents for advice on how to make your child comfortable and excited about learning. Develop back-up plans for getting to school if something comes up or if childcare falls through. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent. Whenever possible, avoid medical appointments and extended trips when school is in session. Thank you for collaborating with us to ensure that your child is at school on time, every day!

<u>Influenza A and B</u>: Hoover families, unfortunately, Influenza A and B have hit the Dubuque area, and we have had multiple confirmed cases of both strains of influenza in our building. In order to prevent this illness from spreading, please keep your child home if he/she has influenza. Please consult your doctor, however, most are recommending that students stay out of school for 5 days to stop the spread of the illness. In addition, the **DCSD Policy is anyone with fever of 101 degrees or greater, vomiting or diarrhea must be free of these symptoms for at <u>least 24 hours before returning to school</u>. If your child has a fever of 100 degrees with symptoms please keep them home. In order to keep everyone as healthy as possible, please keep your child home if they are ill. As always, good handwashing with soap and warm water is the most effective way to prevent illness.**
