ITP TESTING: Students in grades 3-5 will be taking the ISASP (formerly known as ITBS/ ITP) assessments the week of April 8. ISASP consists of several "subtests", including reading, math, and language arts/ writing for all students in grades 3-5, as well as a science test for students in grade 5. The tests are administered with standardized instruction. The results of these assessments are used to gage individual student progress, as well as Hoover School's progress toward meeting overall student achievement goals; however, the results of the ISASP assessments will not be available to schools and parents until the fall. Please help your child prepare for ISASP testing by making sure that he/she gets a good night's sleep, and eats a healthy breakfast. If possible, please make sure that your child is in school for all of the testing days, April 8-12. Make-up tests will be given as needed April 15-19. If you have any specific questions regarding ISASP testing at Hoover School, please contact the Hoover School office at 563-552-3700.

Influenza A and B: Hoover families, unfortunately, Influenza A and B have hit the Dubuque area, and we have had multiple confirmed cases of both strains of influenza in our building. In order to prevent this illness from spreading, please keep your child home if he/she has influenza. Please consult your doctor, however, most are recommending that students stay out of school for 5 days to stop the spread of the illness. In addition, the **DCSD Policy is anyone with fever of 101 degrees or greater, vomiting or diarrhea must be free of these symptoms for at <u>least 24 hours before returning to school. If your child has a fever of 100 degrees with symptoms please keep them home.</u> In order to keep everyone as healthy as possible, please keep your child home if they are ill. As always, good handwashing with soap and warm water is the most effective way to prevent illness.**
