SAFETY ALERTS:

- Student Safety and Morning Drop Off: Please pull all the way to the end of the lane (near the ramp to the playground). In order to ensure the safety of your children, please DO NOT get out of your vehicle. All students should exit from the passenger side, with the assistance of our staff as needed. In addition, please DO NOT PARK in the drive-up lane in the morning before school, or leave your vehicle unattended at any time.
- Morning Arrival on Playground: We are having many students arrive on the playground before 8:25 when our morning supervision begins. I know that spring is here and the sun is out earlier, but our arrival time has not changed. Please help us keep your child, and all children, safe by making sure your child does not arrive before supervision begins at 8:25 am.
- Student Afternoon Pick-Up: Our afternoon dismissal time is now 3:50 pm. Please ensure your child knows the afternoon pick-up plan. When picking up students and walking across the street to a parked vehicle, please use the marked crosswalks manned by our school crossing guards in order to avoid unnecessary injury, or a tragedy. DO NOT cross in the middle of the bus lane or street. If you are picking up a student in a vehicle, please wait to enter the drive-up lane until all school busses and day care vans have exited.
