Safety Alerts:

- When in the Hoover parking lot, please go slow; keep your eyes open for students, parents and staff members, as well as other vehicles in the lot. You are welcome to park in any open parking spaces, but please **DO NOT** park behind other vehicles. Thank you for your help in keeping our parking lot safe!
- The bus lane in the front of the building is reserved for our yellow school buses and registered day care vans. Families doing regular pick-up may access the drive-up lane after the buses and day care vans have exited.
- All students and families should cross the street at our designated crosswalks. When families cross the bus lane, or the middle of the street, it poses a safety concern, as vehicles pulling through the bus lane cannot see students (or even adults) who are walking out in front of a bus. Please help us keep your children safe and prevent any unnecessary tragedy by modeling safety for all students by utilizing the cross walks and **NOT** crossing the bus lane.
