**Health Alert:** With the recent increase in illnesses within the district, the Dubuque Community School District will begin enforcement of health policy requiring students to remain out of school until free from fever (greater than or equal to 100.4F), diarrhea or vomiting without the use of medications for 24 hours to help reduce the spread of illness. In addition, we will be reminding students of the importance of good handwashing.

**Open Enrollment Applications:** This year, just as last year, all open enrollment applications will be submitted online. This will be a smart phone friendly application, and families without computer access may use a computer at school to complete the application if needed. You can find a link to the open enrollment forms on the district website. Secondary applications for grades 6-12 are currently being accepted through 4 pm on Monday, March 2 2020. Applications for elementary open enrollment will be available starting Monday, March 16, 2020.
