Health Curriculum updates for the upcoming months: *December*: Nutrition: This month's topic focuses on healthy eating habits. Arrival/ Dismissal: Please remember breakfast students will be met at Door #1 at 8:00 a.m. Reading Hut students will be met at Door #1 at 8:10 a.m. We request that any parents who are dropping off students for these early morning programs please do not block any vacant parking spots with your vehicles while you wait; please follow the drop-off traffic flow; and do not leave your car UNATTENDED. Note that Irving Choir and Orchestra do meet before school and those students are here for music practice at 7:45 a.m. (We sometimes get asked, "why do those kids get to come in the building early?") Staff supervision does not begin outside until 8:20 a.m. for regular arrival of our students (9:20 a.m. on Fridays). For arrival, Parents please pull ahead and up as far as possible in the car drop-off lane, near assisting staff who will valet your children out of the car. Parents do NOT get out of your car in the valet line, to keep the line moving quickly.
